Solidarity at the time of the pandemic

This volume, entitled “Solidarity in Pandemic Times,” collects the proceedings of the conference held on 11 June 2020 at the Department of Law of the University of Roma Tre.

The volume offers a reflection on the role played by the principle of solidarity during the first year of the pandemic, analyzing the policies that Italy and Europe envisaged to respond to the social, economic and health emergencies caused by Covid-19. In their contributions, the authors explored the impact of the virus control measures in different areas or specific sectors of the legal system, with the risk of widening the already existing gaps and inequalities within society.

All papers are thus characterized by a lowest common denominator, i.e. the “rediscovery” of solidarity as a fundamental element of public debate, whose strength is even more intense in times of crisis.
